Neanderthal Extinction Hypothesis Offered

A Spanish study suggests climate changes might have caused the extinction of the the Iberian Peninsula.

The University of Granada study of Gorham's cave on Gibraltar shows the Neanderthals have been determined by environmental and climate changes, and not by competition with modern humans.

Professor Miguel Ortega Huertas, who led the research, said the findings of the most recent research are an important contribution to the understanding of the Neanderthal extinction and the colonization of the European continent by Homo sapiens.

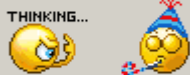
The study -- based on climate reconstructions -- suggests Neanderthal population fluctuations related to climate changes before the first Homo sapiens arrived on the continent. The study found Neanderthals, 24,000 years ago, had to face the worst weather conditions in 250,000 years.

Huertas said the most important finding is that the [data](#) differ from the current scientific understanding.

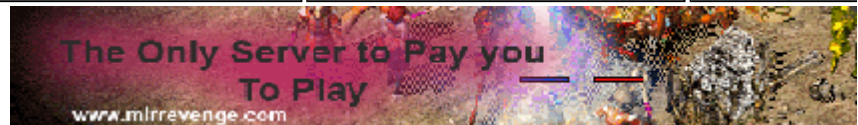
