Salisbury Public Library's newest fundraiser is a real "Day at the Beach." It's a DVD created from the library's postcard and photo collection. Money raised from the sale of the DVDs go to the Trustees' Building Fund.

The DVD was created by Joe Stucker, a Boston University sophomore who has worked at the library for four years, under the supervision of Karen MacInnis, treasurer of the trustees and curator of the Marblehead Museum and Historical Society & the Jeremiah Lee Mansion in Marblehead.
