Globe-Democrat The researchers collected 100 milk samples from 34 breastfeeding mothers from the provinces of Granada and Almeria in Spain. The mothers completed a questionnaire on what Classifieds they ate three days before the sample of breast milk was taken. Ninety-four percent of mothers consumed a hypocaloric diet -- a low number of dietary calories usually 1,000-1,200 calories -- mainly due to low consumption of fat.
