A renewed city, full of **culture** and unique monuments, with a **long and rich history**, located in an **exceptional natural environment**.




A wide range of undergraduate and postgraduate programmes














Development Cooperation

317 students took advantage of mobility in the framework of volunteer programmes, or bachelor's or master's degree work in development cooperation carried out by partner organisations.


Support for postgraduate training of graduates from partner universities to help train human resources.


