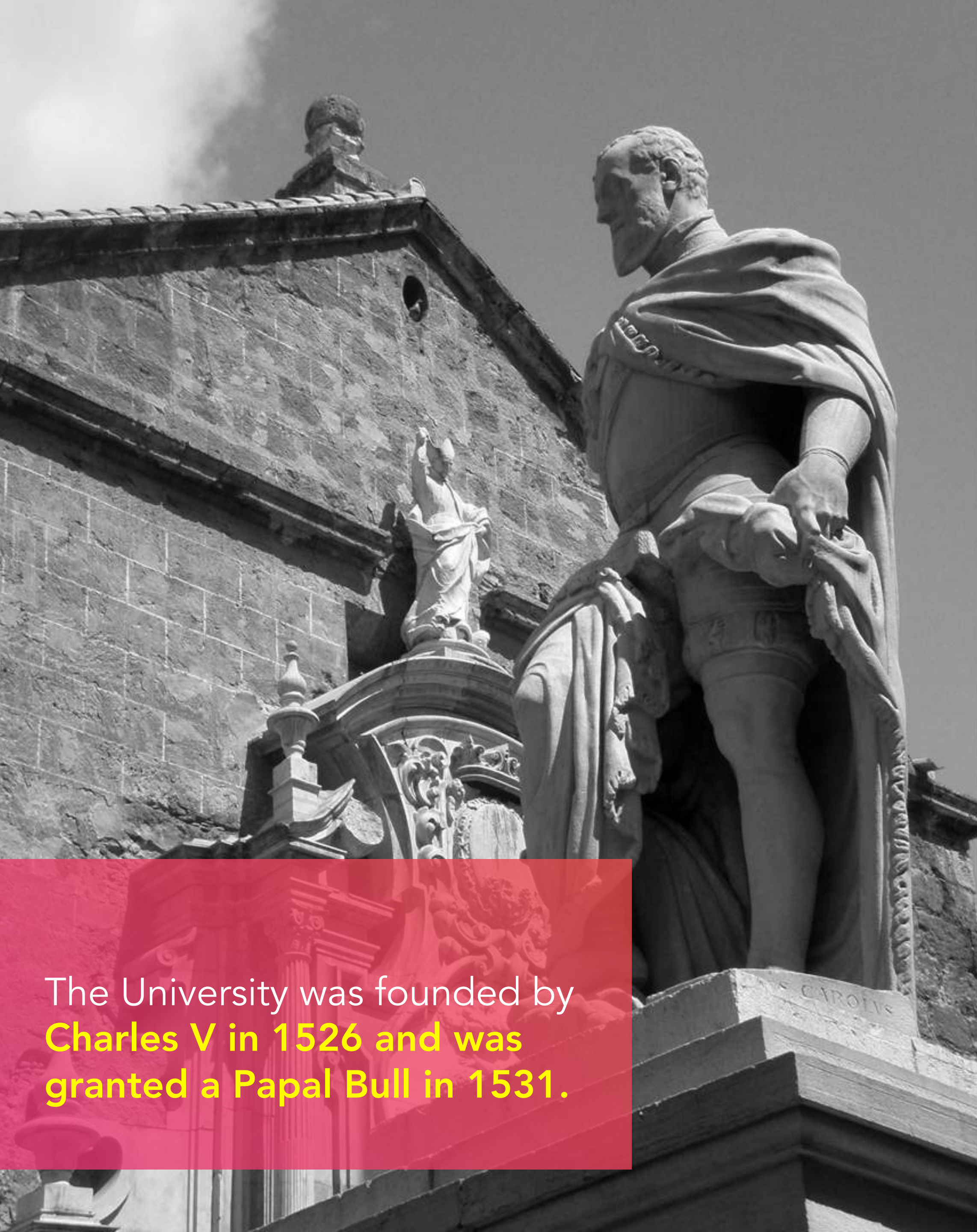

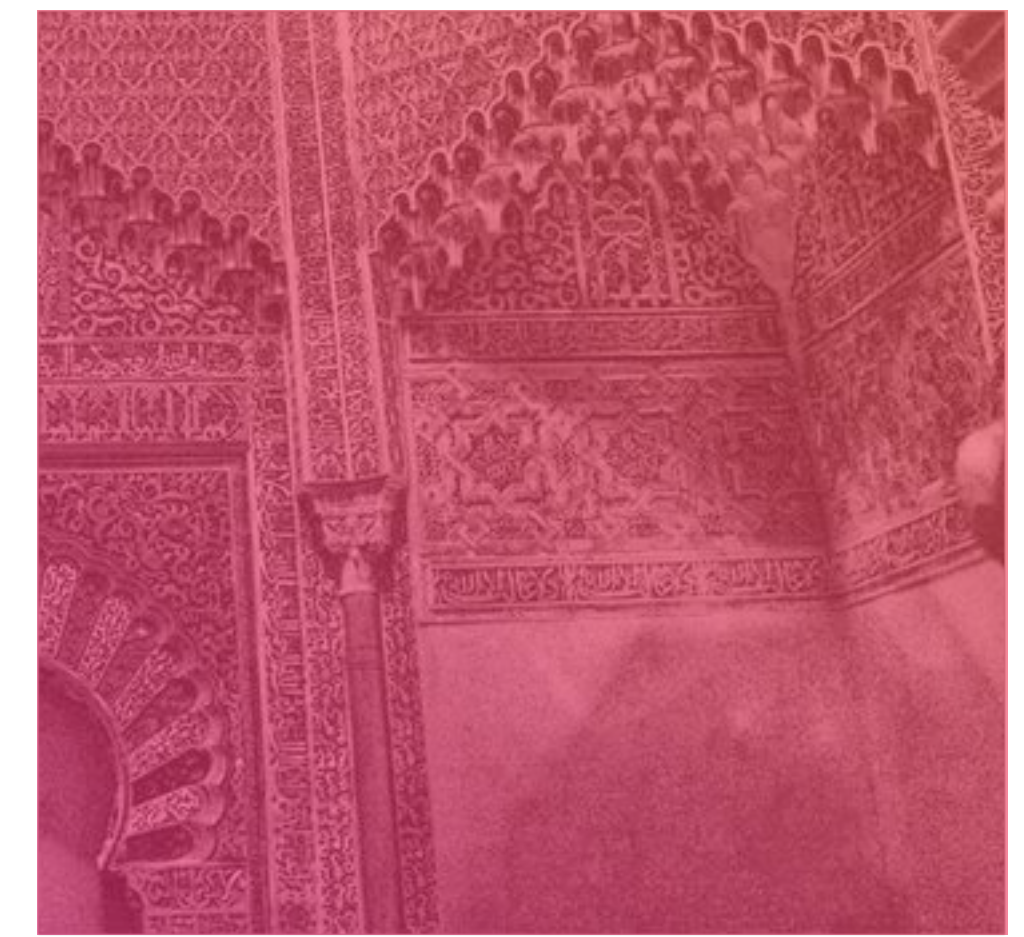
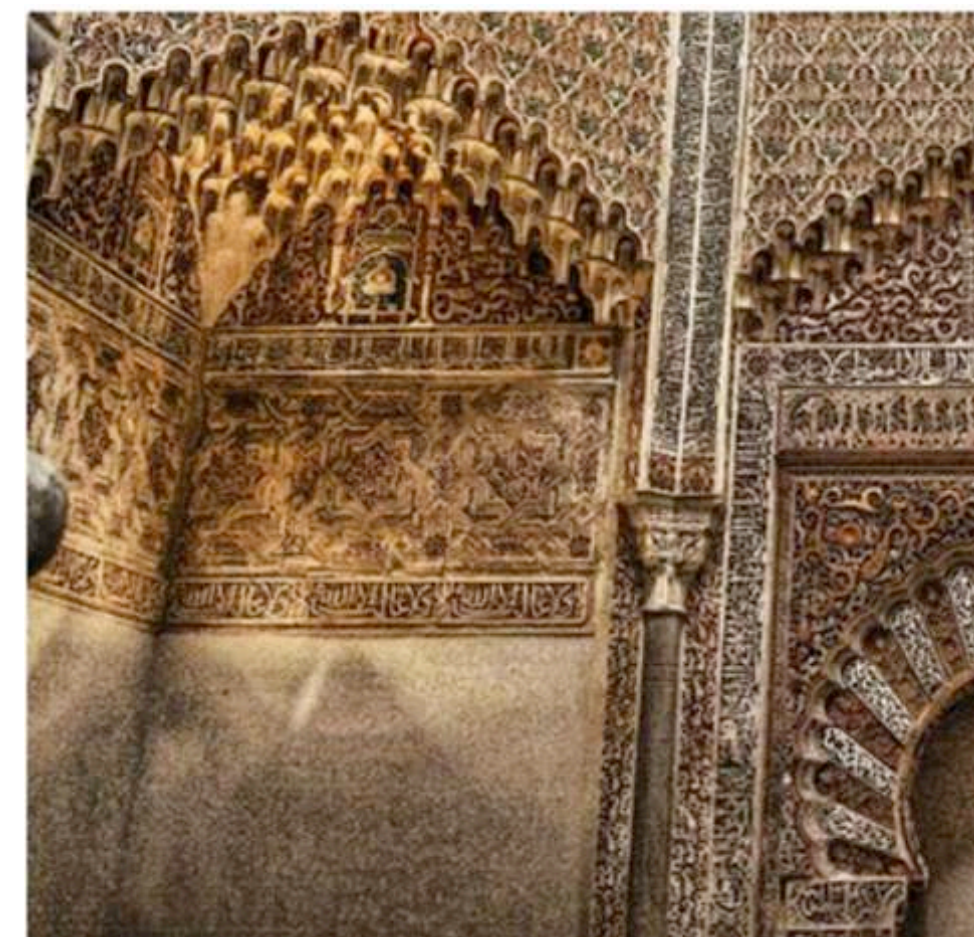

The University was founded by **Charles V in 1526** and was **granted a Papal Bull in 1531.**



It followed in the footsteps of the **Madrasah of Granada**, a type of university founded in 1349 by Yusuf I, the Sultan of Granada, where subjects such as medicine, calculus, astronomy, geometry, and logic were taught.

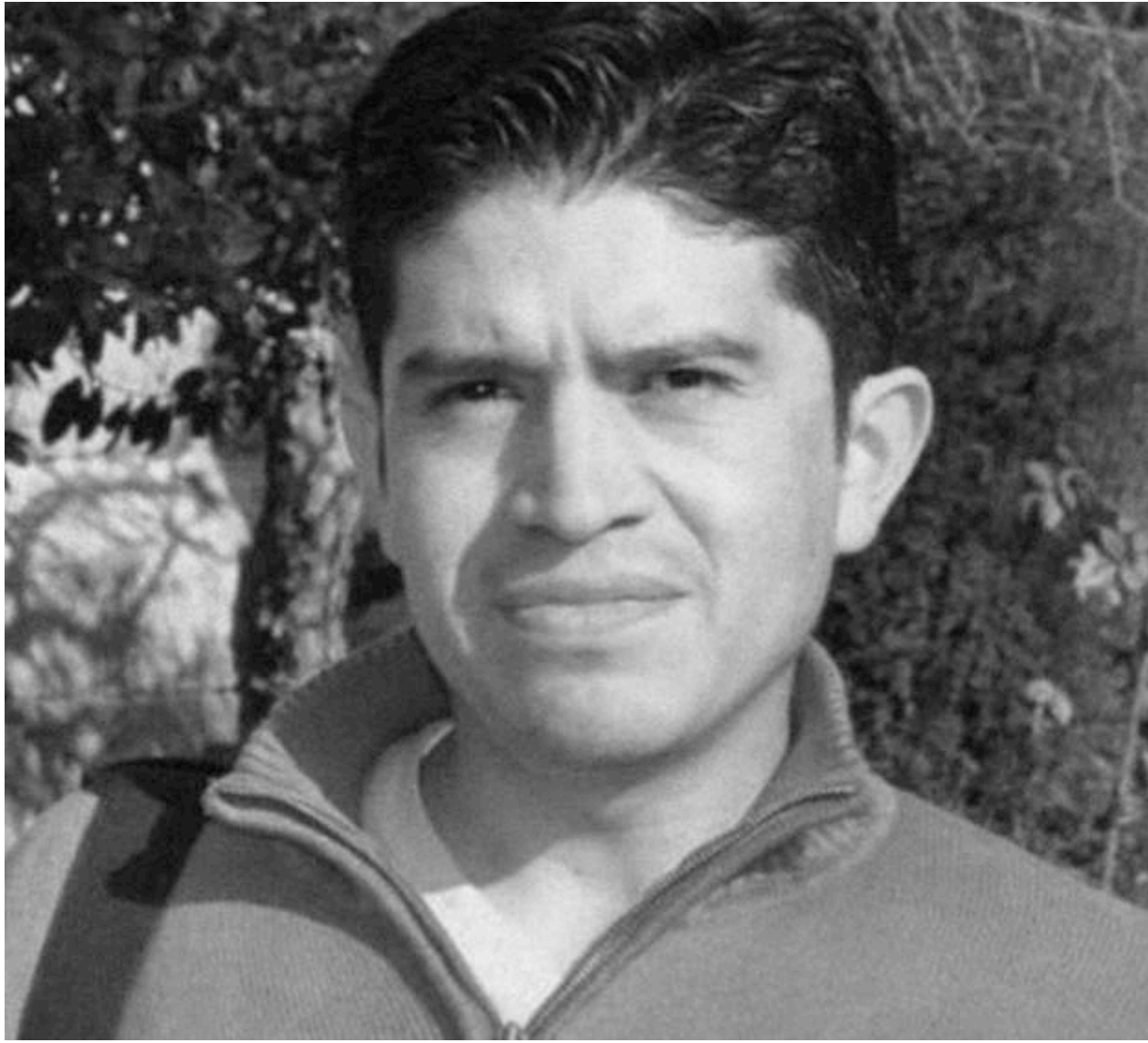


The IWC caters directly for the needs of international doctoral candidates, researchers, and visiting staff before, during and after their mobility period at the UGR.
