Guggenheim Museum 2013-2014 Hilla Rebay International Fellowship



The Guggenheim Museum is currently accepting applications for the Hilla Rebay International Fellowship 2013-2014. In honor of Baroness Hilla von Rebay, the Guggenheim Museum's first director, this unique multi-site ten-month fellowship provides an opportunity for a graduate or recent graduate student to train in the Curatorial Departments at the Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum; the Guggenheim Museum Bilbao; and the Peggy Guggenheim Collection. The fellow will spend a minimum of three months at each site.

The fellowship offers exposure to the operational structure of the multinational museum, as well as rigorous practical museum training experience to individuals interested in pursuing careers in the curatorial field. Each fellow receives funding of \$30,000 (subject to taxes). This annual fellowship is made possible by generous support from The Hilla von Rebay Foundation.

January 13–April 11, 2014: Guggenheim Museum Bilbao, Spain

April 28–July 18, 2014: Peggy Guggenheim Collection, Venice

Minimum MA/MPhil in Art History or related academic fields. Doctoral candidates are strongly encouraged to apply. To be eligible, candidates **must** have fluency in spoken and written English, Spanish, and Italian.
